

90-degree right-angle turn in cable tray



Article Overview

A 90-degree right-angle turn in a cable tray can be achieved using either a fabricated elbow or a pre-manufactured 90-degree bend tray, depending on project requirements.

Fabricated 90-Degree Elbow

A fabricated or mitered bend involves modifying a straight cable tray to form a 90-degree turn. The process typically includes:

- Marking the center line where the bend is desired.
- Cutting 45-degree angles on both sides of the tray to form the elbow.
- V-notching the base to allow the sides to close together.
- Fastening the bent sections with bolts, nuts, and washers.
- Applying rust protection such as cold galvanizing spray if the tray is metallic .

Necessary tools include an angle grinder or hacksaw, measuring tape, set square or protractor, drill, and fastening hardware. This method allows customization on-site but requires precision and proper safety measures.

Pre-Manufactured 90-Degree Bend Trays

Alternatively, pre-manufactured 90-degree bend trays are available in perforated or wire mesh designs. These are designed to integrate seamlessly into a cable tray system and simplify installation:
