Routers used for fiber optic connections are not exactly the same as standard routers; fiber routers are specifically designed to handle high-speed fiber internet and often work in conjunction with an ONT.

Key Differences Between Fiber Routers and Normal Routers

Fiber routers are engineered to work with fiber-optic internet, which delivers data via light signals. They are capable of handling gigabit-level speeds, low latency, and high bandwidth demands, making them ideal for streaming, gaming, and multiple connected devices . In contrast, normal routers are typically designed for DSL or cable connections, which use electrical signals over copper lines and generally offer lower speeds and bandwidth .

Role of the ONT

In a fiber setup, an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) is installed at your premises to convert light signals from the fiber line into electrical signals that your router can use . The router then distributes this connection to your devices via Wi-Fi or Ethernet. Standard routers for DSL or cable connections rely on a modem to perform a similar signal conversion, but the technology differs because fiber uses light rather than electrical signals .
