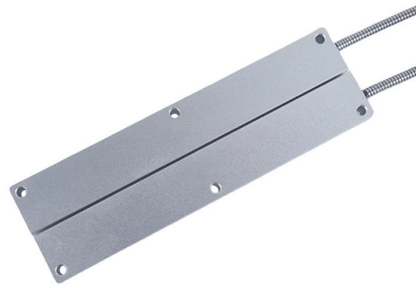


Are there partitions in the middle of the cable tray
