Communication towers are engineered steel structures that elevate antennas and electronic equipment to transmit and receive signals, enabling wireless communication across wide areas.

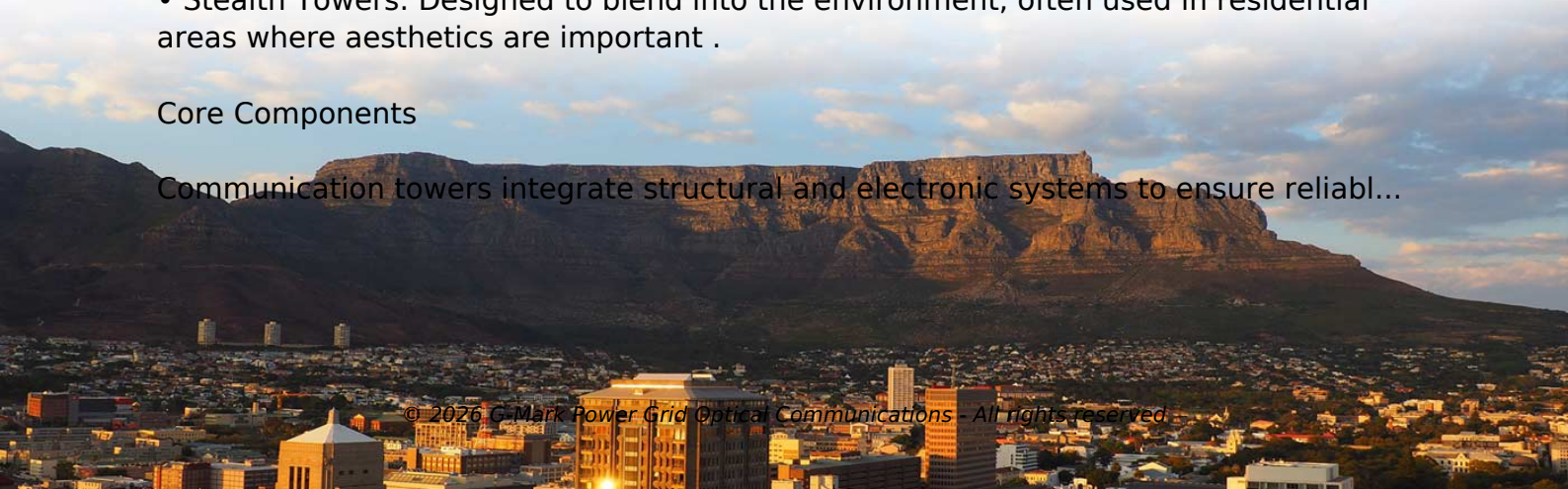
### Structural Types

- **Monopole Towers:** Single tubular poles, ideal for urban areas with limited space. They require a small footprint and are aesthetically clean but have lower antenna capacity compared to lattice towers .
- **Lattice Towers:** Open steel frameworks with three or four legs, offering high strength and the ability to support multiple antennas and microwave dishes. They are resilient to wind and ice loads and are commonly used for major communication hubs .
- **Guyed Masts:** Slim vertical poles stabilized by guy wires anchored to the ground. They are cost-effective, can reach extreme heights, and are suitable for rural or remote areas .
- **Stealth Towers:** Designed to blend into the environment, often used in residential areas where aesthetics are important .
