Bridge Expansion Joints

Expansion joints are critical components in bridges that allow the structure to expand and contract due to temperature changes, traffic loads, seismic activity, and material shrinkage, preventing stress buildup and structural damage . They also protect the bridge from water infiltration, which can corrode reinforcements and damage bearings . Properly designed joints maintain a smooth driving surface and reduce noise and vibration for vehicles .

Common Types of Expansion Joints

- Modular Expansion Joints: Multiple steel or elastomeric modules forming a continuous joint, suitable for large-span highway bridges .
- Finger Joints: Interlocking steel or elastomeric plates that allow longitudinal movement while maintaining a smooth surface .
- Sliding Plate Joints: Steel plates that slide against each other, ideal for bridges with large movements and heavy traffic .
- Strip Seal Joints: Rubber or neoprene seals between bridge segments, providing a watertight barrier while allowing movement .
- Asphaltic Plug and Compression Seal Joints: Used for smaller movements and cost-effective solutions
