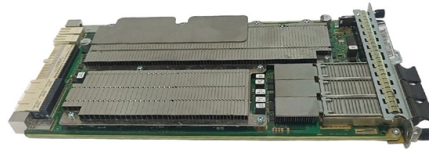


Bridges near Algeria
