- Segregation: Separate power, control, and data cables to reduce electromagnetic interference (EMI) and comply with EMC guidelines .
- Protection: If the tray has sharp edges at the side entry, use edge protectors or grommets to prevent abrasion .
- Tray Type: Ladder, ventilated, or solid-bottom trays can all accommodate side ent...
