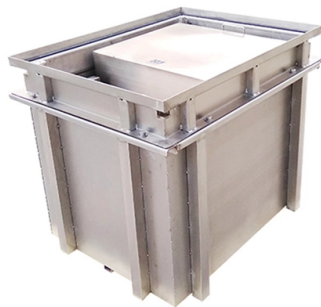


Cable tray cutting at 90 degrees



Article Overview

A 90-degree bend in a cable tray is typically achieved using two 45-degree cuts, careful measurement, and proper fastening to form a precise elbow.

Tools and Materials Needed

- Straight cable tray section
- Cutting tools: angle grinder with cutting disc, hacksaw, or band saw for precision
- Measuring tape, marker, set square or protractor
- Drill with bits, nuts, bolts, and washers for fastening
- Cold galvanizing spray for rust protection
- Personal protective equipment: Kevlar gloves, eye protection, and appropriate footwear

Step-by-Step Cutting Method

- Mark the Center Line: Determine the desired bend location and draw a straight line across the tray base.
- Mark 45-Degree Cuts: From the center line, measure out on both sides by a distance equal to the tray width or use a standard formula (typically 45–82 mm depending on tray size) to mark the cuts .
- Cut the Side Channels: Cut the tray flanges at a 45-degree angle, stopping at the base.
- V-Notch the Base: Remove V-shaped sections on the base where the bend will occur to allow the sides to close together.
- Bend and Fasten: Carefully bend the tray to form a 90-degree elbow and secure with bolts and washers. Apply cold galvanizing spray to protect cut edges from corr...
