- Ladder Trays: Feature side rails connected by rungs, suitable for heavy-duty cables and long runs. They provide strong support and good airflow for heat dissipation .
- Perforated Trays: Solid-bottom trays with holes for ventilation, suitable for medium-weight cables and environments where some protection is needed .
- Solid-Bottom Trays: Fully enclosed trays for sensitive cables requiring protection from dust or mechanical damage
