A properly designed and installed cable tray system will provide. maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is ect the minimum bend ra-dius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray cont d for instrumentation and control applications that require. A cable tray system is a unit assembly of sections and fittings that forms a rigid structural system used to securely fasten or support cables and wiring. The Ladder Tray features light, rugged, tubular steel construction. These fitting are including: elbow, horizontal cross, vertical inside. Cable tray straight-sections support cable runs in a straight line, or they may be cut or bent in configurations like curves, slopes, and tees to accommodate complex cable runs.
