- **Heat Dissipation:** Open designs, such as ladder trays, allow air circulation around cables, reducing overheating risks for high-power installations .
- **Fire Safety:** Properly routed and supported cables reduce the risk of fire spread and improve compliance with safety standards .
- **Durability:** Cable trays are made from materials like steel, aluminum, or plastic, providing long-lasting performance in harsh environments
