They are particularly suitable for low-voltage cables like Ethernet, coaxial, and fiber optics, and feature designs that prevent cable fraying and protect installers from sharp edges (Safe-T-Edge design) while supporting future expansion . **Perforated Trays and Cable Ladders:** Perforated trays provide a solid base with ventilation holes, while cable ladders offer side rails and rungs for maximum strength and airflow. Both types allow easy access for maintenance and cable re-routing, which is essential in dynamic low-voltage environments . **Channel Trays and Strut Systems:** These metal framing systems provide adaptable support for low-voltage cabling, allowing cables to enter or exit at multiple points and accommodating changes in room layout or technology upgrades .

Key Selection Considerations

- **Cable Type and Diameter:** Identify all low-voltage cables (Cat6/6A/7, fiber optic, coaxial, control cables) and note their outer diameters to ensure proper tray sizing .
- **Total Quantity and Weight:** Calculate the total weight per meter/foot of all cables, including a 20–30% growth margin for future expansion .
- **Bend Radius:** Ensure the tray system accommodates the minimum bend radius of sensitive cables, especially fiber optics, to prevent signal degradation .
- **Ventilation and Heat Dissipation:** Low-voltage cables generate less heat than pow...
