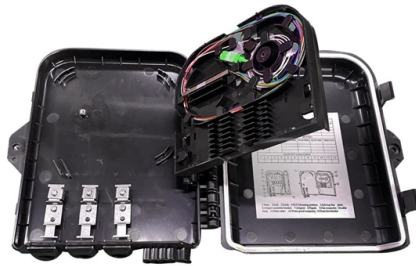


Characteristics of Albanian bridge structures



Article Overview

Albanian bridges range from ancient multi-arch stone structures to modern reinforced concrete and prestressed bridges, reflecting historical eras, evolving construction codes, and adaptation to environmental challenges.

Historical Development

Albanian bridges can be categorized into four main historical periods. In antiquity, multi-arch stone bridges such as Bashtova, Qukesi, and Goliku were constructed, emphasizing durability and masonry techniques . The Middle Ages (7th-15th century) saw fewer distinctive structural innovations, while between the 15th and 19th centuries, 72 bridges of cultural significance were built, including the Mesi Bridge on Shkodër and the Veziri Bridge on the White Drini River . The 20th century introduced concrete, reinforced concrete, and prestressed bridges, designed according to Albanian technical codes and later Eurocode standards .

Structural Types and Materials

- **Stone Arch Bridges:** Predominantly used in historical periods, featuring multiple arches and masonry construction for durability and aesthetic appeal .
- **Reinforced Concrete Bridges:** The most common material in modern national road bridges, providing strength and adaptability to longer spans .
- **Prestressed Concrete Bridges:** Used in recent decades for major infrastructure projects, allowing longer spans and improved load distribution
