Steel and Galvanized Steel

However, low-carbon steel can experience a ductile-to-brittle transition at low temperatures, reducing its reliability in extremely cold conditions, so it may require overdesign for long spans in such environments.

Stainless Steel

Stainless steel (AISI 304 or 316) is ideal for harsh environments, including chemical plants, marine applications, and areas with high moisture or corrosive agents. It offers excellent corrosion resistance, does not exhibit a ductile-to-brittle transition at low temperatures, and maintains strength even in frigid conditions. Stainless steel is often used where long-term durability and minimal maintenance are critical.

Aluminum

Aluminum is lightweight, corrosion-resistant, and easy to install. It performs well in both indoor and outdoor environments and is particularly advantageous in cold climates.
