A snapped fiber optic cable can be repaired by carefully locating the break, preparing the fiber ends, and reconnecting them via fusion or mechanical splicing to restore signal continuity.

Identifying the Break

Fiber optic cable breaks occur when the glass core or cladding is physically severed, interrupting the light path that carries data. Common causes include excavation accidents, environmental stress, or excessive bending beyond the cable's minimum radius . Breaks typically result in complete signal loss or high attenuation, detectable using diagnostic tools like OTDRs (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometers) . Locating the exact break point is critical before attempting repairs.

Preparing the Cable for Repair

- Excavate or access the damaged section carefully to avoid further damage .
- Cut the cable cleanly at the break using fiber optic shears to create workable ends .
- Strip the outer jacket and protective layers using a fiber optic stripper, exposing the internal fiber strands .
- Clean the fiber ends with alcohol wipes to remove contaminants .
- Cleave the fiber precisely using a high-precision cleaver to ensure smooth, flat ends for splicing .
