Network Topology Considerations

For high-reliability networks, ring topologies are widely recommended. In a fiber optic ring, switches are connected in a closed loop, allowing data to flow in both directions. This ensures automatic failover if a link or switch fails, maintaining uptime for critical applications such as telecom backbones, industrial automation, and smart grid systems . Variations include:

- Single ring: Simple closed-loop connecting three or more switches, suitable for smaller networks or zone backbones .
- Multiple independent rings: A central switch connects multiple rings, enhancing port utilization and centralizing control without merging traffic paths .
- Coupled rings: Two rings connected via a coupling switch, allowing selective data exchange while maintaining redundancy .
- Secondary branch rings: Extends connectivity to nearby clusters with partial redundancy .
