

Construction steps for direct burial optical cable laying

Direct burial optical cable installation involves careful planning, trenching or plowing, cable handling, proper burial depth, backfilling, and protective measures to ensure long-term network reliability.

1. Planning and Site Survey

Before construction, conduct a thorough site survey to evaluate soil conditions, terrain, and existing underground utilities. Obtain all necessary permits and right-of-way approvals. Planning helps prevent rerouting, delays, and damage during installation. Determine the cable type (loose-tube, armored, or tight-buffered) based on environmental risks, mechanical stress, and rodent exposure.

2. Safety and Preparation

Ensure all personnel are familiar with OSHA regulations and company safety protocols for buried cable operations. Inspect cable reels for damage, maintain thermal protective coverings, and protect reels from vandalism or environmental hazards. When unspooling cable, use a figure-eight configuration to prevent kinking or twisting, with loops approximately 1.5–2.4 meters in diameter.
