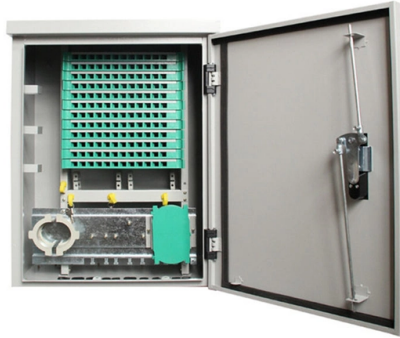


Distribution box blown up

A blown distribution box indicates a serious electrical fault; immediate safety precautions and professional intervention are essential.

Immediate Safety Measures

If your distribution box has blown or shows signs of damage such as burnt smell, scorch marks, melted plastic, or a breaker that won't reset, do not attempt to fix it yourself . First, turn off the main power switch to prevent electric shock. Keep everyone away from the area and avoid touching any live wires or components .

Common Causes

A distribution box can fail due to several reasons:

- Overloaded circuits: Plugging too many high-power appliances into one circuit can trip breakers or blow fuses .
- Short circuits: Damaged insulation, loose wiring, or wires touching where they shouldn't can cause sudden surges .
- Ground faults: Moisture or faulty appliances can create unintended paths for electricity .
- Aging components: Old breakers or fuses may fail under normal loads .
- Voltage drops or inadequate power supply: Long cable runs or insufficient power can stress the system .
