Overview

The IEC 60446 standard, “Basic and Safety Principles for Man-Machine Interface, Marking, and Identification,” establishes global guidelines for identifying electrical equipment terminals, conductors, and wiring colors. Make sure your box sits in a dry, easy-to-reach spot with good airflow. Look for neat cables, solid grounding, and the right wire size. Each circuit should have its own breaker or fuse. Check for UL or CE marks and make sure everything follows local codes. Look for damage and test with a multimeter.
