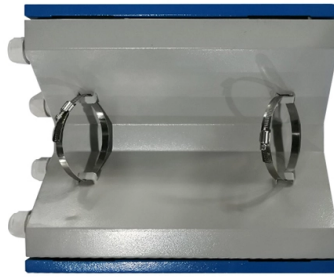


Distribution box sub-bar

A sub-bar, or bus bar, in a distribution box is a conductive strip that distributes electrical power from the main panel to individual circuits within a sub-panel.

What is a Sub-Distribution Board?

A sub-distribution board (sub-panel) is a secondary electrical panel connected to the main distribution board. It is used to distribute power to specific areas or circuits within a building, such as a garage, basement, or additional floors, without overloading the main panel. Sub-panels provide localized control, making maintenance and troubleshooting easier while allowing the addition of new circuits.

Role of the Bus Bar (Sub-Bar)

The bus bar, often referred to as a sub-bar in a sub-panel, is a metal strip or bar that conducts electricity from the main breaker to the branch circuit breakers. It serves as the central point for distributing power efficiently and safely. Key points include:

- Material: Typically made of copper or aluminum for high conductivity.
- Function: Provides a common connection for multiple circuit breakers, ensuring even distribution of electricity.
- Safety: Works with breakers and fuses to prevent overloads and short circuits.
- Types: Bus bars can be configured in single, double, or sectionalized arrangements depending on the sub-panel design and load requirements.
