A distribution box with a tripping device protects electrical circuits by automatically disconnecting power during overloads, short circuits, or faults.

Overview

A distribution box (also called a breaker panel or power distribution unit) is an enclosure that houses multiple circuit breakers or protective devices to manage and distribute electrical power safely to different circuits . The tripping device—commonly a circuit breaker, leakage protector, or battery tripping unit—automatically interrupts the electrical flow when unsafe conditions occur, preventing equipment damage, fire hazards, or electrical shocks .

Common Causes of Tripping

- **Overload:** When the total current exceeds the rated capacity of a circuit, the breaker trips to prevent overheating .
- **Short Circuit:** Direct contact between live and neutral wires causes a sudden surge, triggering the trip .
- **Ground Fault or Leakage:** Current leaking to the ground, often in moisture-prone areas, activates leakage protection .
- **Unbalanced Load:** Uneven distribution of electrical load across phases can cause trips in multi-phase systems .
- **Faulty or Aging Breakers:** Breakers lose sensitivity over time, leading to frequent or unpredictable tripping .
