It provides mechanical stability, distributes the weight of cables evenly, and enables flexible attachment points for various tray types, including ladder, ventilated trough, or solid-bottom trays .

Material and Finish

Channel steel is typically made from low-carbon steel, stainless steel, or aluminum alloys, often with corrosion-resistant finishes such as pre-galvanized coatings, hot-dip galvanization, or epoxy coatings. The choice of material and finish depends on environmental conditions, including moisture, chemical exposure, and indoor or outdoor installation . Standard lengths are usually around 3000 mm, with custom lengths available.

Mounting and Attachment

Channel steel features continuous slots along its length, allowing cable trays to be attached at any point using bolts, nuts, or specialized fasteners. For concrete or structural supports, anchors such as M8, M10, M12, or M16 bolts are commonly use...
