They provide a controlled pathway that minimizes physical stress on delicate fibers, reduces bend radius violations, and allows for easier changes or expansions of the network infrastructure (Cablcon.com), . In data centers, telecommunications hubs, and commercial buildings, trays help maintain signal clarity and reduce downtime by keeping fiber organized and accessible (Cablcon.com), .

- **Protection:** Trays shield fiber optic cables from environmental stressors, accidental pulls, and mechanical damage (Canovate), .
- **Organization:** They allow systematic placement of cables, making maintenance, troubleshooting, and future expansions easier (AZE Systems), .
- **Thermal Management:** Open or mesh tray designs promote airflow, preventing overheating of dense fiber bundles (Apex Tray), .
- **Flexibility:** Modular tray systems can adapt to different environments, from indoor office spaces to industrial facilities, and accommodate changes in cable routing (Canovate),
