

Electrical distribution box dimensions refer to standard charts



Article Overview

Electrical distribution boxes come in a variety of standard sizes, typically ranging from small single-gang boxes around 2" x 3" x 3.5" to large industrial panels several feet tall, with depth and internal volume varying by application.

Residential and Small-Scale Boxes

- Single-gang boxes: Approximately 2" wide x 3" tall x 3.5" deep, commonly used for switches and outlets, with internal volumes around 18 cubic inches to accommodate wiring safely .
- Two-gang, three-gang, and four-gang boxes: Width increases to roughly 4", 6", and 8" respectively, while height remains around 4"; depth varies from 1.5" to 3.5" depending on wire count and device type .
- Junction boxes: Often square or rectangular, typically 4" x 4" with depths from 1.5" to 3.5"; octagonal versions for ceiling fixtures are usually 4" in diameter with similar depth ranges .

Wall-Mount Enclosures

- Common wall-mounted electrical enclosures range from 200 x 200 x 120 mm up to 800 x 600 x 300 mm, with intermediate sizes like 300 x 300 x 150 mm, 400 x 300 x 200 mm, and 600 x 400 x 200 mm frequently used .
- Depth selection depends on internal layout, cable entry space, and future expansion needs, ensuring proper wire bending radius and heat dissipation
