Types and Configurations

- **Rack-Mount Panels:** Panels are typically 1U, 1.5U, or 2U in height, supporting high port densities (up to 96 fibers in 1U and 192 in 2U). They can be empty for custom termination, pre-loaded with adapters, or pre-terminated with pigtails and cables for turnkey solutions.
- **Modules and Cassettes:** Modular panels allow the use of interchangeable adapter packs, splice cassettes, or MPO/MTP modules, providing flexibility for network expansion and high-speed migration.
- **Advanced Optical Modules (AOMs):** Some panels support AOMs for patch-and-splice or patch-only configurations, enabling faster deployment and easier moves, adds, and changes.
