To connect a fiber optic cable from a core switch, use compatible SFP modules, select the appropriate fiber type and number of cores, and consider network topology and redundancy.

Choosing the Fiber Type and SFP Modules

When connecting a core switch to another switch, you need to determine whether to use single-mode or multimode fiber. Single-mode fiber is ideal for long-distance connections and provides higher quality transmission, while multimode is suitable for shorter distances within the same building . Each switch must have compatible SFP or SFP+ ports. For example, Cisco C9300 and C9200 switches support SFP+ modules, and you should use the same type of SFP at both ends, such as SFP-10G-LR for long-range single-mode or GLC-LH-SMD for 1 Gbps single-mode connections .

Determining the Number of Fiber Cores

Each device typically requires two cores: one for transmitting and one for receiving data . If connecting multiple access switches to a core switch, calculate the total cores as 2 cores per link plus additional cores for redundancy. For instance, if a core switch connects to three access switches, a 6-core fiber cable is recommended, with extra cores reserved for future expansion or backup . Pre-terminated multi-strand fiber cables with LC connectors can simplify installation and reduce labor costs
