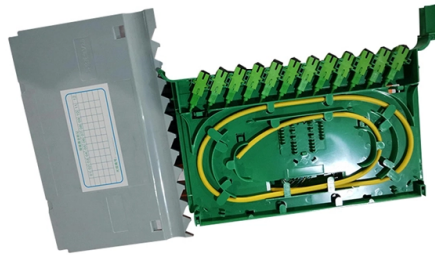

In a home setup, fiber optic cables can be delivered directly to your residence, a configuration known as Fiber to the Home (FTTH) . The fiber line connects to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) near your electrical panel, which converts the light signals into internet data that your devices can use . From the ONT, a Cat6 cable or similar connects to your router, which distributes Wi-Fi or wired connections throughout your home .
