- **Plastic/Polymer:** Cost-effective and flexible, but prone to wear and higher insertion loss. Suitable for short-term or low-performance applications .

Connector Housing Materials

The connector body or housing is usually made from:

- **Plastic (PVC or Polycarbonate):** Lightweight and common for indoor use; compatible with LC and SC connectors .
- **Metal (Nickel-plated or stainless steel):** Provides extra mechanical strength and EMI shielding; often used in harsh environments or outdoor installations
