Common Causes of Fiber Router Issues

- **Hardware Failures:** Faulty routers, transceivers, or switches may lead to slow speeds or outages. Indicator lights like “LOS” (Loss of Signal) can help identify hardware issues .
- **Configuration Errors:** IP conflicts, incorrect routing, or outdated firmware can disrupt network performance .
- **Environmental Factors:** Extreme temperatures, moisture, or electromagnetic interference can affect fiber network stability .

Troubleshooting Steps

- **Inspect Fiber Cables:** Check for visible damage, sharp bends, or loose connections. Replace compromised cables immediately .
- **Clean Connectors:** Use lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol to remove dust or oil from connectors, as contamination is a frequent cause of signal degradation .
- **Test Signal Strength:** Use an optical power meter or OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer) to measure signal loss. Values outside the typical range (-15dBm to -30dBm) indicate issues .
- **Check Hardware:** Swap suspect transceivers with known-good units and reboot ro...
