Step-by-Step Flow of Optical Cable Splicing

- Preparation of Materials and Tools
 - Gather all required tools, materials, and equipment, including cleavers, fusion splicer, protective sleeves, and cleaning supplies ().
 - Verify that the fiber optic cables are correctly labeled and ready for splicing.
- Cable End Preparation
 - Cut the cable to the required length and remove outer jackets.
 - Strip the buffer and coating from the fiber to expose the bare glass.
 - Clean the fiber with alcohol wipes to remove contaminants ().
- Fiber Alignment
 - Place fibers in the fusion splicer or mechanical splice holder.
 - Align fibers precisely using core or cladding alignment methods to minimize insertion loss ().
- Splicing
 - Fusion Splicing: Use an electric arc to fuse the fiber ends, creating a permanent, low-loss joint (~ 0.1 dB) ()....
