

Grounding wire laid along cable tray



Article Overview

To safely lay a grounding wire along a cable tray, run a continuous conductor parallel to the tray, securely bonded at intervals, using corrosion-resistant materials and following electrical standards.

Purpose of Grounding

Grounding a cable tray provides a low-impedance path for fault currents, protecting personnel and equipment from electric shocks, fire hazards, and equipment damage. It also helps reduce electromagnetic interference (EMI) and ensures system stability and reliability .

Materials for Grounding Wire

- Copper Wire: Excellent conductivity, widely used, but more expensive .
- Hot-Dip Galvanized Steel: Durable and corrosion-resistant, suitable for industrial environments .
- Stainless Steel: Ideal for harsh or corrosive environments . For aluminum cable trays, use insulated conductors to prevent electrolytic corrosion, removing insulation only at bonding points with tin or zinc-plated connectors .

Installation Best Practices

- Run a Full-Length Conductor: Lay a continuous grounding wire along the entire length of the cable tray to ensure a reliable path for fault currents .
- Secure Connections: Bond the grounding wire to each or alternate tray sections using grounding clamps, bolts, or welds to maintain electrical continuity and mecha...
