A guide sleeve is a protective component designed to encase a fiber optic splice or reinforce a fiber optic cable section to prevent bending below its minimum bend radius, which could degrade signal quality (). These sleeves are essential in both field and indoor installations, including FTTH, FTTx, and backbone networks ().

- Single Fiber Protection Sleeves
 - FP-03 Series: Standard for durable protection of single fiber splices in field installations ().
 - FPS01 Series: Micro sleeves for optical components where small packaging is critical, offering flexibility in length and coating size ().
