The cost of fiber optic cables varies widely depending on type, fiber count, and application. Single-mode fiber (OS2) typically costs between \$0.09 and \$1.52 per foot for bulk purchases, while multimode fiber (OM3/OM4) can range from \$1.50 to \$6 per foot at retail, with higher prices for pre-terminated assemblies or high-count cables like 288-strand backbones. Installation costs, including trenching, splicing, and termination, can further increase total project expenses, sometimes exceeding \$3 per foot for complex outdoor runs.

Factors Driving High Prices

- **Raw Material Costs:** Glass, polymer, and copper components fluctuate in price, directly affecting cable costs.
- **Supply Chain Constraints:** In early 2026, single-mode fiber prices surged dramatically in China due to tight supply, causing rapid increases in finished cable prices.
- **Fiber Type and Count:** Higher fiber counts and specialized cables (armored, tactical, or outdoor-rated) are more expensive due to additional materials and manufacturing complexity.
- **Labor and Installation:** Underground or long-distance installations require more labor and equipment, raising costs compared to indoor or aerial runs
