

# How far can a switch be connected to a fiber optic cable



## Article Overview

The maximum distance from a fiber optic cable to a switch depends on the fiber type, data rate, and transceiver capabilities, with multimode fiber typically limited to hundreds of meters and single-mode fiber supporting tens of kilometers.

### Fiber Type and Distance

Single-mode fiber (SMF) is designed for long-distance transmission. Standard OS2 single-mode fiber can support distances over 10 km for typical 1G-10G Ethernet links, and with proper transceivers and amplification, distances can exceed 100 km in backbone or metro networks. The 1310 nm wavelength is commonly used for medium-range links, while 1550 nm is preferred for long-distance, low-attenuation applications. Multimode fiber (MMF) is optimized for short-range connections, such as within data centers or campus networks. OM3 and OM4 multimode fibers typically support up to 300-400 meters for 10G Ethernet, while lower-speed links (1G Ethernet) can reach up to 550 meters. Modal dispersion and higher attenuation limit multimode fiber's effective distance.

### Factors Affecting Distance

- **Attenuation:** Signal loss occurs as light travels through the fiber. Higher-quality fiber with low dB/km ratings allows longer distances.
- **Dispersion:** Chromatic and modal dispersion can degrade signal quality, especially in multimode fiber, reducing maximum distance.
- **Transceiver Power and Sensitivity:** The optical power budget of the switch's transceiver...
