Optical distribution boxes (ODBs) serve as intermediate nodes in fiber networks, distributing fibers from feeder cables to multiple subscriber endpoints. Standard core counts for these boxes usually range from 8 to 48 cores, which allows them to handle small to medium-scale deployments efficiently, such as residential buildings or corridor installations . For larger or high-density applications, some boxes can support 72, 96, or even more cores, providing scalability for future network expansion . Factors influencing core count selection include the number of subscribers served, anticipated network growth, and the type of fiber splitters or patch panels used. Lower-core boxes (8–12 cores) are common for single-family homes or small indoor nodes, while 24–48 core boxes are typical for multi-dwelling units or small commercial buildings . High-density ODFs in data centers or telecom exchanges may exceed 96 cores to accommodate hundreds of fiber connections . Design considerations also matter: higher core counts increase distribution capacity but require careful fiber management to prevent bending, stress, or damage. Modular designs often allow technicians to add trays or panels to expand capacity without replacing the entire box . Unused cores are frequently reserved for future growth, ensuring flexibility in network planning . In summary, the typical optical distribution box has 8–48 cores, with modular or high-density options extending up to 96 cores or more, depending on deployment scale and future expansion needs .
