Single-mode fiber (SMF) supports distances up to 40-100+ kilometers for standard applications, while multimode fiber (MMF) is typically limited to 300 meters to 2 kilometers. The actual distance depends on factors including fiber type, wavelength, network equipment, and signal. Fiber optic cable can be run anywhere from 300 meters up to 80 kilometers (roughly 50 miles) depending on the cable type, transceiver used, and network standard.
