

How to blow and lay fiber optic cables



Article Overview

Fiber optic cables can be installed by either pulling (manual or mechanical) or blowing (air-assisted jetting), with blowing being more efficient for long ducts and complex routes.

Pulling (Laying) Method

The pulling method involves manually or mechanically drawing the fiber optic cable through a pre-installed duct or conduit. This traditional approach is straightforward but has limitations: it requires more manpower, is slower, and can be challenging in long ducts or routes with multiple bends. Friction between the cable and duct wall is a major factor, and excessive pulling force can damage the cable or create microbends that impair signal quality. Pulling is generally preferred for short, simple runs or when blowing equipment is unavailable .

Blowing (Jetting) Method

Blowing, also called fiber jetting, uses high-speed compressed air combined with a mechanical pushing force to install the cable into a duct. The process begins by pushing a few hundred meters of cable into the duct using a tractor or rollers. Then, compressed air is introduced at the duct inlet, creating a high-speed airflow that keeps the cable in a floating state, reducing friction and allowing it to travel longer distances efficiently .
