

How to connect a dual-diaphragm fiber optic patch cord

A dual-diaphragm fiber optic patch cord contains two optically isolated fibers, allowing independent signal transmission with high efficiency and flexible connector options.

Structure and Design

A dual-diaphragm fiber optic patch cord consists of two separate optical fibers housed within a single cable assembly. Each fiber is optically isolated, which prevents signal interference between the two channels. One end of the cord typically terminates with a dual ferrule guiding pin or guiding socket connector, while the other end can either have a dual ferrule connector or separate FC connectors for each fiber. This design allows for precise alignment and reliable optical coupling.

Functionality

These patch cords are capable of transmitting independent optical signals simultaneously. When paired with a Separate Light Path 2x2 Fiber-optic Rotary Joint, each fiber can carry a distinct signal without crosstalk. Using a 1x2 Fiber-optic Rotary Joint with dual patch cords can improve optical efficiency, although it is more expensive than using a branching patch cord with a 1x1 rotary joint.
