

How to connect a fiber optic router to a factory

To connect a fiber optic router to a factory, use an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to convert the fiber signal, then extend the network via Ethernet or fiber media converters to reach factory devices.

Step 1: Prepare the Necessary Equipment

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Converts incoming fiber optic signals into electrical signals compatible with standard networking equipment .
- Fiber-ready router: Ensure it supports gigabit speeds or higher, with WAN or SFP ports for fiber input .
- Fiber optic cable: Single-mode or multi-mode depending on distance, typically with LC or SC connectors .
- Ethernet cables and switches: To distribute the network within the factory.
- Optional fiber media converters: Useful for extending fiber over long distances or connecting multiple buildings .

Step 2: Connect the Fiber to the Router

- Install the ONT near the fiber entry point from your ISP. Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT .
- Link the ONT to the router using a high-quality Ethernet cable (Cat6a or higher) from the ONT's LAN port to the router's WAN port .
- Power on the ONT and router and wait for the status lights to indicate a successful connection
