

How to connect a fiber optic router to broadband

A fiber optic router connects to broadband through an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts the fiber signal into an Ethernet signal that the router can use.

Key Components

- **Optical Network Terminal (ONT):** This device is provided by your ISP and serves as the bridge between the fiber optic line and your home network. It converts the incoming light signals from the fiber into standard electrical signals compatible with routers and computers .
- **Fiber Optic Cable:** Typically a thin, yellow cable with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors, it carries the optical signal from the ISP to the ONT .
- **Ethernet Cable:** Connects the ONT to the router's WAN or Internet port, transmitting the converted electrical signal .
- **Fiber-Ready Router:** A router capable of handling high-speed data, often supporting Wi-Fi 5 (802.11ac) or Wi-Fi 6 (802.11ax) for optimal performance .

Step-by-Step Connection

- **Install the ONT:** Place the ONT near the fiber entry point in your home, typically on a wall or in a closet. Connect the fiber optic cable from the ISP to the ONT's optical port, ensuring the connector clicks securely .
- **Power On the ONT:** Use the provided power adapter and wait for the status lights to stabilize, which may take a few minutes .
- **Connect the Router:** Use an Ethernet cable to link the ONT's Ethernet port to the router's WAN or Internet port
