

How to connect a high-speed fiber optic cable to a router

To connect a high-speed router to a fiber optic cable, you need an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to convert the fiber signal, then link it to your router via Ethernet.

Required Components

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Provided by your ISP, this device converts the incoming fiber optic light signals into electrical signals your router can use .
- Fiber Optic Cable: Typically thin and yellow, with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- High-Speed Router: Ensure it supports gigabit or multi-gigabit speeds and has a WAN or SFP port compatible with the ONT .
- Ethernet Cable: Cat6 or Cat6a recommended for high-speed data transfer between the ONT and router .
- Power Cables: For both the ONT and router.

Step-by-Step Connection

- Locate the Fiber Outlet: Identify where the ISP's fiber line enters your home or office .
- Connect Fiber to ONT: Remove protective caps and carefully insert the fiber optic cable into the ONT's optical port, ensuring a secure click . Handle the fiber by its plastic housing to avoid damage .
- Power ON the ONT: Plug in the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize, indicating a successful connection to the ISP network .
- Link ONT to Router: Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port...
