3. **Patch Panels** Patch panels serve as centralized points for organizing multiple fiber connections. They simplify routing, labeling, and maintenance, especially in dense installations like data centers. Modular patch panels are recommended for easy upgrades and port reconfiguration.
4. **Fiber Pigtails** Pigtails are short fiber cables used for splicing to permanent fiber lines. They are fused to the main fiber and terminated in a connector, providing a stable and long-lasting connection.
5. **Cable Management Tools** Cable organizers, trays, and loopbacks prevent tangled cables, maintain proper bend radius, and ensure airflow. Proper cable management reduces signal distortion and simplifies maintenance.
