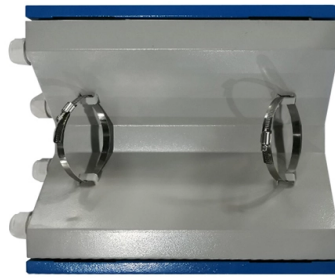


How to cool down outdoor electrical distribution boxes
