

How to fit a cable tray into a server rack

Properly fitting a cable tray into a server rack involves careful planning, selecting the right tray type, and ensuring secure installation while maintaining airflow and accessibility.

Step 1: Plan Your Layout

Ensure the tray route does not interfere with airflow, cooling paths, or other equipment .

Step 2: Select the Right Cable Tray

Choose a tray type based on cable type, weight, and density:

- Ladder trays: Ideal for heavy or large bundles, allow airflow and easy access.
- Perforated trays: Suitable for long spans or heavier cables.
- Trough trays: Good for tightly grouped cables and minimizing electrical interference.
- Ensure the tray can support current and future cable loads without deformation .

Step 3: Measure and Prepare

Measure the length and height of the tray path, leaving extra length for slack at bot...
