

How to install a fiber optic terminal box

Installing a fiber optic terminal box involves careful preparation, secure mounting, proper fiber splicing, and organized cable management to ensure network reliability and signal integrity.

Preparation

- **Select the Installation Location:** Choose a location that is easily accessible, protected from environmental hazards, and suitable for the type of FTB (indoor or outdoor) you are using .
- **Capacity Planning:** Determine the number of fibers to be terminated to select a box with sufficient ports and future expansion capacity .
- **Gather Tools and Accessories:** Required items include the FTB, fiber optic cables, adapters, cable cutters, strippers, labeling tape, cleaning agents, gloves, screws, drill, and cable ties .
- **Inspect the Box:** Check for defects or damage before installation .

Mounting the FTB

- **Wall or Rack Mounting:** Secure the FTB on a wall or a 19-inch standard rack using expansion screws or other appropriate fasteners . Ensure the front panel is accessible and the box is stable.
- **Cable Entry Preparation:** Prepare the fiber cable ends according to supplier instructions. Protect bare fibers during this stage to prevent damage .
- **Pierce Cable Entry Diaphragm:** If the box has a rubber diaphragm at the entry hole, pierce it before inserting the cable .
