Laying fiber optic cables in walls requires careful planning, protective conduit use, and gentle handling to prevent damage and signal loss.

Planning the Route

Start by determining the final location of your Optical Network Terminal (ONT) or network equipment. Map the pathway through walls, basements, attics, or existing conduits, aiming for the shortest and straightest path to minimize bends and stress points on the fiber . Avoid areas with extreme temperatures, high foot traffic, or sharp edges that could damage the cable jacket .

Selecting the Right Cable

For indoor runs, use plenum- or riser-rated fiber optic cables. Single-mode fiber (OS2) is preferred for long distances and future-proofing, while multimode fiber (OM3/OM4) is suitable for shorter runs . Pre-terminated cables with connectors like SC/APC or LC simplify installation and reduce the risk of splicing errors .

Using Conduits and Protection

Run the fiber through flexible low-voltage conduit or innerduct when passing through walls or high-traffic areas. This protects the cable from accidental damage, pests, and future renovations . Ensure the conduit is compatible with the environment, such as UV-resistant for exposed sections....
