

How to make a jumper wire for a cable tray



Overview

In general, to make a jumper wire, follow these steps. Collect all the necessary parts. Solder the male header. However, you must use copper bonding jumpers if the tray is painted or has expansion joints for movement. A connection resistance above 0. A jump wire, is a short electrical wire with a solid tip at each end (or sometimes without them, simply "tinned"), which is normally used to interconnect the components in a breadboard.
