Bundle and Route Carefully

Group pigtails by type, color, or destination using Velcro straps or cable ties, but avoid over-tightening, which can damage the fibers. Keep bundles parallel and aligned along the tray edges or panel guides to create a uniform appearance .

Maintain Proper Bend Radius

Ensure that all loops and turns in the pigtails respect the minimum bend radius specified for the fiber type. Tight or uneven loops not only look messy but can also increase signal loss. Use the tray's built-in routing channels to guide fibers smoothly .
