1. Prepare the Installation Site Install the distribution box in a dry, ventilated, and accessible location at an appropriate height (typically around 1.5 meters) to facilitate maintenance and inspection. Ensure the wall or surface is stable and free of obstructions, and select a box with the correct IP/NEMA rating for indoor or outdoor use . 2. Turn Off Main Power Always switch off the main power supply before starting any wiring to prevent electrical shock . 3. Secure the Box Fix the box firmly to the wall using expansion bolts or screws. Ensure it is level and stable to avoid tilting or loosening over time . 4. Prepare Wires Strip the insulation to the correct length, leaving enough conductor exposed for a secure connection but not so much that it risks short circuits. Use a wire stripper for clean cuts . 5. Connect Terminals Follow the principle: phase wire to phase terminal, neutral wire to neutral terminal, ground wire to ground terminal. Tighten screws or crimp wires securely to ensure good conductivity . 6. Arrange Wires Neatly

- Use zip ties or cable organizers to bundle wires neatly.
- Avoid tangling or contact with sharp edges.
