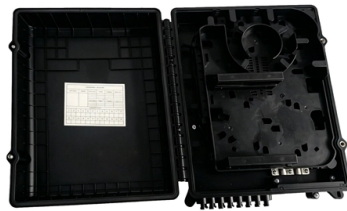


How to plug in a fiber optic broadband router



Article Overview

To connect a fiber optic broadband router, you first link the fiber cable to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), then connect the ONT to your router via Ethernet, and finally power on both devices.

Equipment Needed

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Converts fiber optic signals into electrical signals for your router, usually provided by your ISP .
- Fiber optic cable: Typically a thin yellow cable with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- Router: Ensure it supports fiber input, often via a WAN or SFP port .
- Ethernet cable: Cat6a or higher is recommended to maintain high-speed performance .
- Power adapters for both ONT and router.

Step-by-Step Setup

- Install the ONT
- Locate the fiber wall outlet where your ISP's fiber line enters your home .
- Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's optical port, handling the connector by its plastic housing to avoid damage .
- Power on the ONT and wait 2-5 minutes for the status lights to stabilize .
- Connect the ONT to the Router
- Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to the router's WA...
